The bomb forever changed the institution of the presidency since only the president controls "the button" and, by extension, the fate of the world. The bomb also placed new emphasis on the president's military role, creating a cult around the commander in chief. The tendency of modern presidents to flaunt military airs, Wills points out, is entirely a postbomb phenomenon.
