Here 's how: As you can see, i-adjectives can be turned into adverbs by changing the “ i ” 「い」 to “ ku ” 「く」 , while for na-adjectives, we just replace the “ na ” 「な」 with “ ni ” 「に」 .

Adverbs in Japanese are not as tightly integrated into the morphology as in many other languages. Indeed, adverbs are not an independent class of words, but rather a role played by other words. For example, every adjective in the continuative form can be used as an adverb; thus, 弱い yowai 'weak' (adj) 弱く yowaku 'weakly' (adv).
